ADMISSIONS

Applicants for admission to **RTS** are considered without regard to sex, age, color, or national origin. All individuals who meet admission requirements will be accepted into **RTS**. Assessments will be administered to all prospective students according to their academic background and experience.

Degree programs are completed during a two-year course of study. Life and ministerial experience, as well as, previously earned college credits will be considered on an individual basis.

TUITION AND FINANCIAL PLANS

RTS is committed to offering you the highest level of academic studies in the Word of God at an affordable cost. As a religious exempt school, students will not be eligible to receive Federal Student Aid or Federal Loans.

In an effort to keep tuition expenses very affordable, **RTS** provides payment plans to accommodate the needs of each student. Students may also secure personal loans to pay for tuition expenses or make monthly payments.
